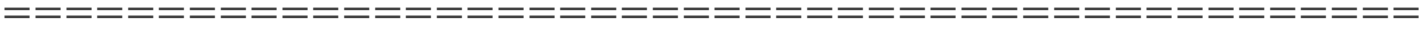
Tuesday September 14<sup>th</sup> Menopause the Musical
