Camp Rules

First and foremost, the staff take their responsibility to provide for the safety and welfare of all Campers very seriously. The rules below are important to the safety of all campers and the overall success of camp. Please take a moment to review the Camp Rules with your camper prior to your session. Campers who break any of the rules are subject to certain disciplinary action.

Rules for Camp

1. Please be responsible for your belongings and be respectful of the camp and other campers' property. Treat others in the same way you want to be treated.
2. At camp, horseplay and physical confrontation are not allowed. This includes but is not limited to punching, hitting, slapping, kicking, spitting, etc.
3. Do not leave any areas of the camp without permission from your counselor, including going to the restroom, whether on camp grounds or on a field trip.
4. Campers need to listen to direction from all summer staff counselors.
5. Please pay attention during rules and take them seriously during activity times and field trips.
6. Campers are to remain courteous and respectful at all times.
7. Foul language or name-calling or Bullying of any kind will result in conduct reports and will not be tolerated.
8. Wear appropriate clothing each day of camp.
9. If you find something that does not belong to you, please turn it into a counselor.
10. Do not share your money or food with any other camper.
11. No electronics are allowed in camp. This includes cell phones.
12. Come to camp with a positive attitude – getting ready for a great day of camp!
13. All campers are expected to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Contact an adult counselor immediately if you don't feel well or if someone gets hurt.

On Field Trips:

14. Make sure you always wear your camp t-shirt on Field Trip days!
15. Each Monday you will get a wristband with our contact information on it. Please be sure to wear it all week!
16. Stay seated on the bus, with back against the back seat and your bottom against the bottom of the seat.
17. Eating and drinking is not allowed on the bus.
18. Please remain calm on the bus, keeping all arm, legs and belongings out of the aisle.
19. When walking to and from field trips – please make sure you walk in a line, patiently waiting instruction from your counselors for next steps.
20. Most importantly and overall: Have FUN!
