 - Ask a 3-question health screening about COVID-19 symptoms for your immediate family each morning of camp.
 - Every day of camp, your camper(s) will have their temperature taken via a no touch forehead thermometer and must not have a temperature of 100.4 or higher.
 - Campers must also not have any symptoms including: Cough, Shortness of Breath, Difficulty Breathing, Respiratory Symptoms, Chills, Muscle Pain, Headaches, Sore Throat, loss of taste or smell.
 - After your camper(s) have been checked, our staff will send your child(ren) into the building with their belongings, where we will have a hand sanitizing stations to start each day of camp!
