

CRPA Slow Pitch Adult Return to Play

As to all applicable persons, people should be instructed that if they are exhibiting symptoms of possible exposure to COVID-19, such as fever, that they should not come to events or work until such time as the participant has been tested and/or cleared.

Teams

- Should not enter dugout until the other team has completely exited the dugout.
- Recommended when entering the complex gates (Bells Ferry entrance & Towne Lake entrance) patrons should walk down the right side of the walkways. Outgoing traffic should the left side of the walkways.
- Recommended players wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before, during, and after games. Use of hand sanitizer frequently when washing hands is not available.
- Bats must be outside dugout prior to the game for inspection.
- Teams should clean their dugout of all trash and other items after each game. Teams are encouraged to disinfect hard surface areas (benches, bat racks, etc.) upon first arriving at a dugout.
- Prohibited from pre-game & post-game handshakes/high fives.
- All softballs should be wipe down and sanitized before entering the game from the dugout.
- The team at bat will be responsible for ball exchange during coed games, placing a ball in play after a foul ball, and retrieving foul balls.
- Recommended to reduce the capacity of spectators (1:1) on game days.
- Recommended teams waiting to play or spectators not use the bleachers/stands and should bring chairs to sit around the field promoting social distancing.
- As for spectators, it is required that all minors, outside the field of play, must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Adults with minors in attendance must use active supervision at all times and should be within 6ft of the adult responsible for them.
